Air pollution: small off-road engines.

Introduced by Assemblymember [Marc Berman](#) and [Lorena Gonzalez](#)

Purpose

- Additional regulations would set new emission standards, drastically increasing costs for products with small off-road engines.
- Portable generators would need to meet new emission standards and would require all portable generators to be zero-emission.

- 10/09/21 - Chaptered by Secretary of State - Chapter 753, Statutes of 2021.

- Recommended Position: **Oppose**
- Forces small business owners to purchase expensive battery-powered hardware. New electric hardware cannot accommodate certain work environments let alone the overall public infrastructure does not support such drastic changes.
