AB-2390 (2021-2022)

Theft: Aggregation of Amounts and Diversion

District 66 Assembly Member Al Muratsuchi

Summary

Amends existing Proposition 47 (2014) provisions by allowing separate instances of retail theft to be counted in aggregate toward the existing \$950 felony threshold approved by voters in 2014.
If possible, a pretrial diversion program if first offered, could lead to a job for the individual. If the individual denies the offer, the crimes would be considered felonies.
