AB-2390 (2021-2022)

Theft: Aggregation of Amounts and Diversion

Summary

- Amends existing Proposition 47 (2014) provisions by allowing separate instances of retail theft to be counted in aggregate toward the existing \$950 felony threshold approved by voters in 2014. If possible, a pretrial diversion program if first offered, could lead to a job for the individual. If the individual denies the offer, the crimes would be considered felonies.

Status

- **History:** 04/26/22 - In committee: Set, final hearing. Failed passage.
- **Votes:** 04/26/22 (FAIL) - Assembly Public Safety - Ayes: 0, Noes: 5, NVR: 2 - Do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on [Appropriations].

Position

- LASCC's Position: tbd

- While we agree there should be alternatives, we recommend LASCC take a position to advocate for a system that allows us to look at pre-incident behaviors and to identify those most at risk.
