Purpose

Would change the way the state selects projects for transportation funding.

History 09/11/23 - Ordered to inactive file at the request of Senator Blakespear.

Votes: 09/01/23 (PASS) - Sen Appropriations - Do pass as amended

Position

- Recommended Position: Oppose
- A companion bill to AB 6 (Friedman), legislation that BizFed has already considered and stated its opposition. These two pieces
 of legislation jeopardize transportation improvement projects across Los Angeles.
- May affect the allocation of billions of dollars in state transportation funding.
- This bureaucratic overlay could slow progress on repairing and improving highways, roads overpasses, and bridges across
 Southern California. Major highway improvements, from the 15 to the 5 that are already well-along in the planning process
 could be in jeopardy should these bills move forward.
