CALIFORNIA PLASTIC WASTE REDUCTION REGULATION INITIATIVE

Proponents Michael J. Sangiacomo, Caryl Hart, and Linda Escalante

Purpose

Requires <u>Cal Recycle</u>, which is an unelected body to adopt regulations with regards to the use of single-use plastic packaging. Enacts a per item fee on single-use plastic packaging and food ware.

History

Did not make it to the November 2022 ballot.

Position

- While we want to be environmentally responsible, this bill is more ballot box legislation which will provide unelected officials to make policy which is estimated to cost Californians upwards of 9 billion dollars per year.
- Additionally, this initiative is being proposed as more of an unnecessary money grab at the same time as a similar and far more responsible SB-54 is already being proposed by Senator Ben Allen (see the next Senate bill). BizFed and many others are joining the <u>Stop the Tax on Working Families</u> collective in order to oppose this ballot measure.
