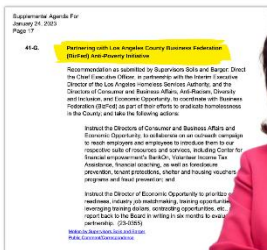


OUR MOTION PASSED
