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DIALYSIS PROPOSITION

Proposition 29 - Dialysis Clinic Requirements Initiative (2022)

Service Employees International Union-United Healthcare Workers West (SEIU-UHW)

Summary

• A "yes" vote <u>supported</u> this ballot initiative to require dialysis clinics to have at least one physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant while patients are being treated; report data on dialysis-related infections; and not discriminate against patients based on the source of payment for care.

Position

- LASCC's Position: Oppose
- The union group, SEIU-UHW, is working on their third attempt in trying to pass their heavily defeated (63% no votes in 2020) bill
 in the mid elections with almost identical terms as the previous proposals. This proposition for 2022 mandates that every
 dialysis clinic in California have a physician or nurse practitioner in every clinic during all operating hours doing administrative
 duties. This measure would increase dialysis clinic costs by up to \$367 million annually or between \$345k and \$608k per clinic.
 This will reduce access to needed dialysis services and increase costs on patients/consumers.
