• Requires building managers/property owners to install and provide training material to tenants on how to use a tourniquet meant for tactical combat casualty care.

- <u>Votes</u> 07/13/21 (PASS) Assembly Judiciary Ayes: 10, Noes: 1, NVR: 0 Do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on [Appropriations].

Position

- LASCC's Position: Oppose
- Completely opens the door for liability and create a cottage industry for ambulance chasing attorneys.
